

## **SOLAR LIGHT CAP** INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

# THIS DOCUMENT WILL COVER THE STEPS NECESSARY TO INSTALL A SOLAR LIGHT CAP ONTO BUCKLEY FENCE POSTS.

## **TOOLS REQUIRED**

- No. 2 Phillips head Screwdriver
- Rubber Mallet

## INCLUDED

- Solar Light Caps.
- Solar Light Mountng bracket.
- Solar Light Mountng hardware.
- Solar Light Mountng Cap with predrilled holes.
- 10 32 Self Tapping screws.

## **INSTALLATION STEPS**

#### STEP 1

Place the pre-drilled cap on the post and tap on it with the rubber mallet untl it is fully seated. Cover the post cap with a rag so as not to damage the Mounting Cap surface.







#### STEP 2

Remove the mounting bracket from the Solar Light Cap box and center it onto the mounting cap. Remove the 10-32 self-tapping screws from their packaging and place them through the slots on the mounting bracket and into the pre-drilled holes on the mounting cap. Snug up the screws with the No2 Phillips screwdriver.

The mounting bracket is found in the Solar Light Cap box.

10-32 self-tapping screws are provided with the order. They are packaged in the same over- pack box as the solar caps and mounting caps. They came in a small white box or a small plastic bag.









#### STEP 3

Remove the small bag that has the screws and anchors foun inside the same box that has the Solar Light Cap. From that bag, remove the two small countersunk screws. The anchors and anchor screws are not needed for this installation and can be dicarded. Take care not to lose the two small countersunk screws.

Solar Light Cap mounting hardware bag is found inside the box that contains the Solar Light Cap itself. Circled are the two small countersunk screws that will be needed to complete the installation.

#### STEP 4

Remove the Solar Light Cap from the box and press and hold the button found underneath the solar panels until the lights come on, indicating that the Solar Light Cap is "on." If the light does not turn on, leave the cap face up (so the solar panels are exposed to the sun) in the sun for at least an hour. After that, press and hold the button until the lights turn on. (You have to press and hold, then release, then press and hold the button again to turn the lights on).





#### **STEP 4 CONTINUED**

Press and hold the above button to turn the Solar Light Cap on.

The Solar Light Cap's lights will turn on briefly to indicate it is on.



#### STEP 5

Align the two mounting holes on the bottom of the Solar Light Cap to the holes on the mounting bracket. Place the two small counte sunk screws into those holes and tighten the screws with the No2 Phillips head screwdriver. Repeat these steps for every post getting a Solar Light Cap.
