

CRATE END RETURN PLAN

- Gather crate ends and tops.
- Stack the ends as shown in this presentation.
- Band them as shown and they can be picked up with a fork lift and no pallet is necessary.
- Call Buckley Fence, we will arrange and pay for shipping. You just have to load the cubes of crate ends on the truck with a fork lift.



Stack one crate end inside and on top of the other as shown (all stacks must be the same).

**Put 4 doubles side by side and put all 4 top plates on top (2 shown).
Take care to do them all the same. Its now ready to be banded.**



First, wrap the horizontal band around the center as shown. This pulls all four together. When pulling this tight, shake them to be snug. Make sure the 4 stacks of two are in line and tighten the banding.



The second (vertical) band is trickier. It must be wrapped around the reinforced members and not the outer straps that are weak. See how it is inside the weak straps?
